

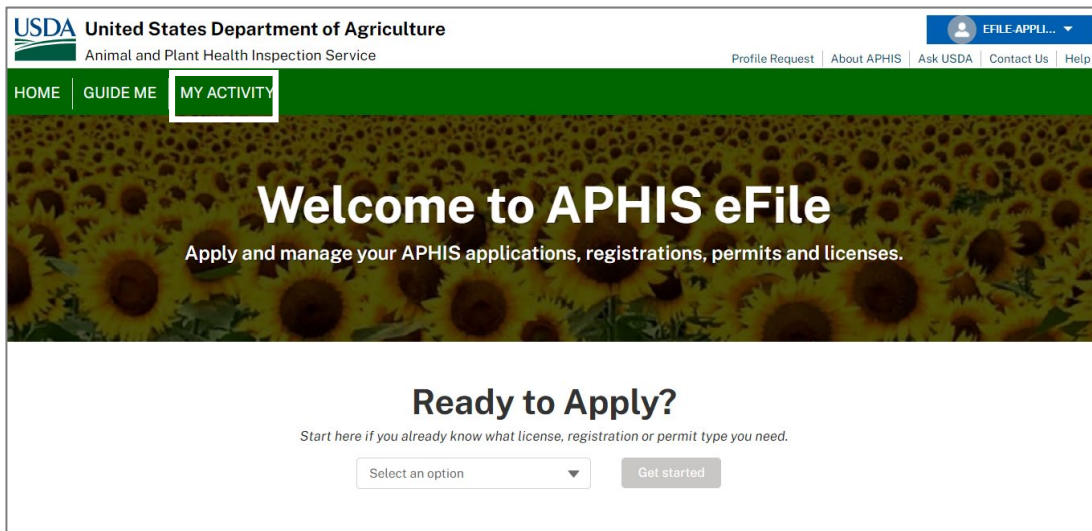
Finding Amended or Renewed PPQ 587 Permits

The steps below illustrate **how to find your amended or renewed permit** once it has been issued. Access APHIS eFile at efile.aphis.usda.gov/s/.

When searching for your amended or renewed permits in ACE, search using the original permit number and **do not include any additional characters**, such as A1, R1, in your ACE search. Access ACE at ace.cbp.dhs.gov/.

Step 1: Navigate to the My Activity page

- Log into APHIS eFile at efile.aphis.usda.gov/s/.
- On your Homepage, **select the My Activity tab**.



Step 2: Search for your original APHIS Permit Number

- **Type in your original APHIS permit number** using the search bar.
 - To find your amended permit, add a “A” at the end of the number (i.e. 556-20-201-0015A1)
 - To find your renewed permit, add “R” at the end of the number (i.e. 556-20-201-0015R1)

Note: do not include the “A” or “R” in an ACE permit search

Step 3: Navigate to the Permit Details Page

- Select **View Details** to see the applicable permit.

Step 4: View Permit PDF

- Select **View Permit PDF** to see a copy of your amended or renewed permit.
 - The updated permit number displays below the application number in the PDF.
