



IPHis: Surveys Defined

**Users should consult survey protocol and management direction for proper data entry using the survey types and associated fields below.

SAMPLING

Field	Description for use
Collect Sample	Trap/Host found; take sample
Inaccessible	Access to trap restricted by temporary environmental situation; difficult to access

TRAPPING

Field	Description for use
Install	Install a new trap
Monitor	View installed trap for presence of pests
Recover	Retrieve incorrectly placed/fallen trap
Release	Used under biocontrol programs to indicate a biocontrol delivery
Relocate (Install)	As part of relocating, this field indicates <i>installation</i> at the new site.
Relocate (Remove)	As part of relocating, this field indicates <i>removal</i> from the initial site.
Remove	Withdraw a trap for any reason
Remove (Missing)	Withdraw non-present trap
Replace Lure	Replenish lure
Replace Lure (Missing)	Replenish absent lure
Replace Trap	Exchange damaged, full, or worn-out trap
Replace Trap (Missing)	Install an absent trap
Replace Trap and Lure	Exchange damaged, full, or worn-out trap and lure

VISUAL

Field	Description for use
Inspect	View trap or area for trap placement or presence of pests
Count	Determine number of pests/hosts found
Scout	View area for potential trap placement
Site Visit	Stop at a residence, place of business or area to meet with a person to discuss pest issues
