There were 11 surveillance inspections conducted at 11 different sites for a total of 110 fish sampled this month. Samples are targeted to moribund and fresh mortalities when possible. The water temperatures continued to increase in response to the warmer air temperatures. All sites with fish in the water remained Category 1 and were scheduled for monthly sampling. Routine harvest continued. No cages were confirmed positive this month.
